

## RESOLUTION NO. 2012-03-01

### AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO LEASE EXCESS C-BT UNITS

**WHEREAS**, the City has previously purchased 5,373 C-BT units and has entered into a lease agreement with Riverside and Quality Water to lease 2,837 C-BT Units; and,

**WHEREAS**, the foregoing total C-BT units will likely exceed the City's needs for 2012; and,

**WHEREAS**, City staff has previously attempted to lease the City's excess units through a bidding process; and,

**WHEREAS**, City staff has found that a bidding process is not conducive to the City obtaining a favorable lease price; and,

**WHEREAS**, granting the City Manager the authority to negotiate and authorize the lease of such excess units will greatly assist the City in obtaining a favorable lease price for the excess units.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN, COLORADO:**

**SEC. 1:** The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and lease the 2012 excess C-BT units.
