RESOLUTION ADJUSTING THE PROCESS TO SET FEES AND ADOPTING NEW SCHEDULE OF FEES

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Morgan relies upon fees to provide many services to customers and citizens; and,

WHEREAS, fees associated with the services provided by the City require adjustment from time to time to account for the increase in the costs to provide such services; and,

WHEREAS, Council has previously adopted a schedule of fees as a part of an appropriations ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, Council seeks to increase the efficiency of providing these services as well as the schedule of fees and changes thereto; and,

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed an updated Schedule of Fees as a part of the 2013 budget process as attached hereto and incorporated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN, COLORADO:

SECTION 1 The City Council will make adjustments to the Schedule of Fees by Resolution rather than by Ordinance, and as such, this resolution and accompanying Schedule of Fees is intended to supersede all previous fee schedules adopted by ordinance.

SECTION 2 Effective January 1, 2013, the City hereby adopts the Schedule of Fees (attached hereto as Exhibit A).

If plan review is required, a plan review fee shall be paid at the time of submitting plans and specifications for review. **Plan review fees shall be equal to sixty-five percent (65%) of the total permit fee for a permit to do the work proposed. When plans are incomplete or changed so as to require additional plan review, an additional plan review fee shall be charged at the rate which has been established...*

All Contractor Registrations expire December 31 of each year regardless of date issued.

NOTES:

- Valuation is based on unit costs of materials per square foot and on the occupancy classification and type of the project. See attached standard building valuation table. Remodel projects that include all the trades will be calculated at 60% of the unit costs.

2. When the fee is paid, it will include the cost of the Building Permit, Plumbing Permit, Electrical Permit and Mechanical Permit. Separate permits will be issued, but the fee is based on the aggregate project.
3. Inspections and re-inspections on any item shall be at the rate of \$20.00/hour weekdays, and on weekends and holidays the rate shall be \$30.00/hour with a minimum one hour charge.
4. In addition to the permit fee, a fee for plan review, plan checking and inspections by outside consultants shall be imposed for the amount of the actual costs incurred. The determination of whether outside consultants will be used shall be made by the building official.
5. The permit fee for manufactured housing units (HUD or UBC approved) shall be determined as follows: foundation or basement requirements and other on-site improvements shall be based on the square footage schedule; electrical and plumbing work shall be based on the schedule for plumbing and electrical.
6. The City Building Department will not perform real estate inspections.
7. Any person who fails to obtain a permit prior to the commencement of any work, or any person who fails to obtain a Certificate of Occupancy prior to the use of a project or portion thereof prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy, shall be subject to the penalties of Sec. 21-1-90 (a) et seq. of the *Fort Morgan Municipal Code (2010)*.

Saturday afternoon, Christmas Eve and the day after Thanksgiving will be accommodated at an additional fee of \$1,000.00.

CEMETERY VAULT POLICY

The City of Fort Morgan requires the use of a burial vault with the following minimum specifications:

1. The Vault will be resistant to water, minerals, chemicals or acids normally found in the soil.
2. The Vault must withstand at least 61,000 pounds of pressure over the entire grave and be able to withstand 6,000 pounds per square foot of pressure.

The FEE for installation of a burial vault is:

1. \$30.00 for installation of a fiberglass or plastic vault.
2. \$30.00 for installation of a steel or cement vault provided that the vault company entirely installs the vault and repairs and replaces any damaged areas in the cemetery. A charge of time and materials will be assessed for any vault installation that requires the City to assist with the installation or repair damaged areas.

CEMETERY HEADSTONE PLACEMENT EXPENSES:

It will be the responsibility of the family; priced at market rate; and will comply with the following dimensions:

Foundation-Double Lot – 22" W x 120"L x 6"D


