

RESOLUTION No. 2013-08-04

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN CONCERNING THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT

WHEREAS the United States of America, acting through the Attorney General for Civil Rights (the "US"), conducted an audit of the City of Fort Morgan in 2011; and,

WHEREAS a number of issues of non-compliance with the Americans with Disabilities act within the City were raised by the US; and,

WHEREAS the City has corrected several structures and projects to become compliant, but still has some outstanding projects to complete; and,

WHEREAS the US and the City have proposed to complete the outstanding projects upon the timeline presented in the proposed settlement agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN, COLORADO:

Sec. 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the **SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN CONCERNING THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT.**

INTRODUCED, PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED this 6th day of August 2013, the vote upon roll call being as follows:


