

RESOLUTION No. 2014-08-04

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF SOFTWARE FROM INSIGHT PUBLIC SECTOR.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Morgan has several computers utilized in the operation of City functions and services; and,

WHEREAS, these computers require software programs to function and perform services; and,

WHEREAS, the City is able to contract with Insight Public Sector to obtain the appropriate software licenses with Interstate Compact pricing; and,

WHEREAS, the Interstate Compact pricing presents a significant savings on the cost of the software.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN, COLORADO:

SECTION 1: The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement for the purchase of software licences for the total of \$89,474.14, billable over three years subject to annual appropriations as follows:
