

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-02-01

A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING THE ELECTRIC RATES FOR THE ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT AND SYSTEM ENTERPRISE OF THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that the Residential, Small Commercial General and Municipal rates be adjusted as follows: that the Consumer Charge be increased from \$3.34 to \$7.91 and that the Energy Charge be increased from \$.0802 to \$.0855; and,

WHEREAS, it has also been recommended that Commercial Demand Meters, Large Commercial, Irrigation, and Interruptible Load Management Service rates be adjusted as follows: that the Consumer Charge be increased from \$3.34 to \$6.13 and that the Energy Charge be increased from \$.0738 to \$.0791; and,

WHEREAS, it has also been recommended that Transmission rate be adjusted as follows: that the Consumer Charge be increased from \$3.34 to \$6.13 and that the Energy Charge be increased from \$.0716 to \$.0769; and,

WHEREAS, it has also been recommended that Residential Demand rates be adjusted as follows: that the Consumer Charge be increased from \$3.34 to \$6.13 and that the Energy Charge be increased from \$.0738 to \$.0791; and,

WHEREAS, it has also been recommended that Residential Area Lighting and Commercial Area Lighting rates be adjusted as follows: rates be increased from \$7.25 per lamp to \$7.79 per lamp; and,

WHEREAS, it has also been recommended that Highway Fog Lighting rate be adjusted as follows: rate be increased from \$86.88 per lamp to \$93.40 per lamp; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 16-1-50, *Code of the City of Fort Morgan*, “[c]harges for the supply of electric. . . service[s] shall be, from time to time, established by resolution of the City Council”; and,

WHEREAS, the “Ninth Revised” Sheet No. 15 and 16 (of the published tariff of electric rates of the City of Fort Morgan, Colorado, incorporated herein by this reference) shall be effective February 1, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN, COLORADO:

SECTION 1 Effective February 1, 2015, for all utility bills generated on or after such date, the City hereby adopts the Electric Rates (attached hereto as Exhibit A).
