

## RESOLUTION NO. 2015-03-03

### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE SECOND ADDENDUM TO THE IGA WITH LOG LANE VILLAGE CONCERNING WASTE WATER

**WHEREAS**, the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment issues and regulates Permits for treating and discharging waste water; and,

**WHEREAS**, a Permit is utilized by Fort Morgan for the treatment of waste water; and,

**WHEREAS**, Fort Morgan and Log Lane Village have an Intergovernmental Agreement for the acceptance and treatment of wastewater from Log Lane Village; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement must be amended to comply with EPA Pretreatment regulations imposed upon Fort Morgan as well as applicable provisions in the Fort Morgan Municipal Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN, COLORADO:**



INTRODUCED, PASSED, APPROVED AND ADOPTED this 17<sup>th</sup> day of March 2015, the vote upon roll call being as follows:


