A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS AND AUTHORIZATION FOR THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT FOR THE FORT MORGAN COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND MUNICIPAL CODE UPDATE

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Local Affairs ("DOLA") provides grant funding through the Energy Impact Assistance Fund program to local governments for qualifying projects; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Morgan applied for a grant through this program to assist with the costs of completing a Comprehensive Plan and updates to portions of the Fort Morgan Municipal Code; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Morgan is anticipating a Grant Agreement for an award in the amount of \$90,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Grant Agreement for DOLA EIAF 07665 will require the Mayor's signature and the Council's Authorization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN, COLORADO:

SECTION 1. The City of Fort Morgan hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign the Grant Agreement for DOLA EIAF 07665.


