

RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE LETTER OF SUPPORT REGARDING BLOCKED RAILROAD CROSSINGS.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Morgan is requesting the assistance of State Senator Greg Brophy regarding blocked railroad crossings within the City of Fort Morgan; and

WHEREAS, blocked railroad crossings create hazards, inconvenience and a negative economic impact upon the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, it requires state action to regulate the conduct of railroads at rail crossings; and

WHEREAS, City Council directed that the Superintendent of Public Works prepare a letter in support of reconsideration of Senate Bill 07-021 concerning limitations on the conduct of rail operations at grade crossings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fort Morgan, Colorado that:

SECTION 1: The Council of the City of Fort Morgan hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign the Letter of Support prepared by the Office of the Superintendent of Public Works regarding blocked railroad crossings (attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference).
