## Free Legal Help date & schedule change

"Free Legal Help" will be changing days in 2017. The program will now meet on the second Monday of each month in the PC lab. Although the first appointment start time will remain the same at 3:30 p.m., the slots will now be 15 minutes in length. This allows staff to add one more appointment per session. Since this program is extremely popular, adding an additional appointment time will be beneficial for patrons.

"Free Legal Help" is a program that is available in the PC lab on the second Monday of each month. Using a laptop that is set up in the lab, patrons can speak to a lawyer over the Internet for free. Each patron has a limited 15-minute session. There are six time slots available for each installment of this program. Appointment time slots are available from 3:30 to 5 p.m. **Patrons must call for an appointment** time in order to reserve a space. This program is very popular and usu-

ally books up two weeks prior to the date the program is offered. We do take alternate reservations and very often we will have a last-minute cancellation. This means that it is possible to get an appointment by being placed on the alternate list. This program has won several Colorado state awards for excellence in serving the public with free legal help.
