

## RESOLUTION NO. 2017-12-01

### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN MEMORANDUMS OF AGREEMENT FOR RIGHT OF WAY ACQUISITION BY THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

**WHEREAS**, the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”) owns and maintains Interstate 76, which runs through the City of Fort Morgan; and,

**WHEREAS**, CDOT is in the process of designing alterations and improvements to Interstate 76, which requires additional right of way access to be acquired from the City of Fort Morgan; and,

**WHEREAS**, CDOT has offered to purchase the additional right of way from the City of Fort Morgan through various Memorandums of Agreement which are attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibits A, B, and C.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN, COLORADO:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the Memorandums of Agreement between the City of Fort Morgan and the Colorado Department of Transportation attached hereto as Exhibits A, B, and C.
