

## RESOLUTION NO. 2019-12-01

### INCREASING THE WATER RATES FOR THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN, COLORADO

**WHEREAS**, the continued responsible water development for the City of Fort Morgan is in the best interests of the City; and,

**WHEREAS**, the projected revenues of the water rates were analyzed in a study completed in 2018 by Raftelis Financial Consultants; and,

**WHEREAS**, the 2018 rate study projects additional increases in fixed costs per year as well as additional capital improvement projects for the water enterprise; and,

**WHEREAS**, an increase in the water rates would create additional revenue within the Water Enterprise Fund to allow for future infrastructure improvements, rate stabilization and major expansions that will benefit the customers; and,

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Sections 17-5-10 and 18-3-10 of the *Fort Morgan Municipal Code*, all water and wastewater rents, rates and charges payable within the City are to be established by Resolution of the City Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN, COLORADO:**

**Section 1.** Effective January 1, 2020, for all utility bills generated on or after such date, the City hereby adopts the Water Rates attached hereto as Exhibit A.
