

ORDINANCE NO. 1309

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10-4-20 OF THE FORT MORGAN MUNICIPAL CODE TITLED "CURFEW IMPOSED ON CERTAIN MINORS"

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Morgan, Colorado (the "City") has been duly organized and is validly existing as a home rule city under Article XX, Section 6 of the Colorado Constitution and the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-15-401, the City by and through its City Council ("Council"), possesses the authority to adopt laws and ordinances within its police power in furtherance of the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, from time to time it becomes necessary to amend City ordinances to adjust for changing laws or to clarify the behavior that is being regulated; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to ensure clarity in the minor curfew ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds it desirable and appropriate, and in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of its residents, to amend Section 10-4-20 of the City Code to place definitive timeframes for when curfews apply to minors within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated as conclusions, facts, determinations, and findings by the City Council.

Section 2. Section 10-4-20, entitled Curfew imposed on certain minors, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 10-4-20. Curfew imposed on certain minors.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any minor to loiter, idle, wander, drive, ride, stroll or play in or upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, playgrounds or other public grounds, public places and public buildings, places of amusement and entertainment, vacant lots or other unsupervised place after the hour of 11:00 p.m., any day except Friday and Saturday when such time shall be extended to 1:00 a.m. the following day **and before the hour of 5:00 a.m.**; provided, however, that the provisions of this Section do not apply to a minor accompanied by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor, or where the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business **such as work or school when** directed by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.

(b) Any minor convicted of a violation of this Section shall be punished by a fine.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, provision, paragraph, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is held, or decided to be unconstitutional, invalid or enforceable for any

reason, such decision shall not affect the constitutionality, validity, or enforceability of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.


