A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF AN INTERIM BANK ACCOUNT

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Morgan maintains bank and investment accounts for the safekeeping of City funds; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Morgan, during a transition between third party health insurance administrators, is required to open an additional account for the payment of healthcare claims from the City's self-insurance funds; and,

WHEREAS, new accounts opened by the City require signatories to be designated and authorized.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT MORGAN, COLORADO:

Section 1. Required signatories on City accounts shall be as follows:

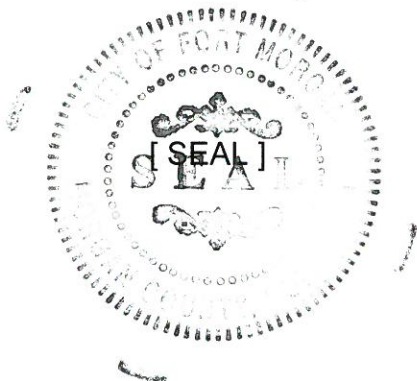
1. The City of Fort Morgan H.C. Checking Account shall require two signatures from this list:

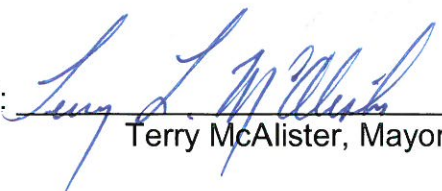

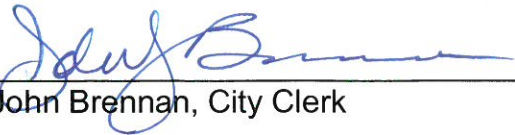
