
Howard Rollin Exhibit open in The J.V. Ostermiller Founders Room (Museum Lower Gallery)

Howard Rollin (1909-1983) grew up on his family's home- stead in Wildcat Canyon near Weldona. He lived in Morgan County for 70 years, starting in 1912. A selection of his works from the muse-


