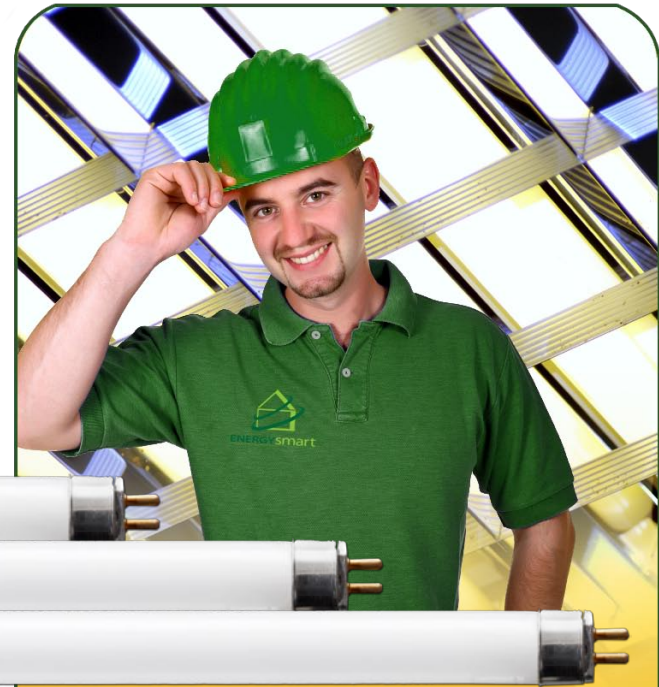

## 2009 ENERGYsmart Commercial Lighting Program

### **High Bay Lighting**

Replace metal halide with high output fluorescent high bay

\$50 per fixture

### **Fluorescent Lighting**

Replace any T12 fluorescent light fixture with T8 or T5 and electronic ballast

\$15 per fixture

### **Area Lighting\***

Replace 400-watt or greater mercury vapor light with High-pressure sodium

\$30 per fixture

Replace less than 400-watt mercury vapor light with high-pressure sodium

\$20 per fixture

### **LED Lighting**

Replace incandescent exit signs with LED

\$10 per fixture

*\*Exterior lighting excluded*



The **ENERGYsmart Commercial Lighting Program** is provided by the Municipal Energy Agency of Nebraska in partnership with your local municipal utility to encourage commercial customers to replace less efficient lighting products with new, high-efficient lighting.

Converting to more efficient lighting can have a favorable impact on businesses bottom line. Interior lighting, on average, makes up about 30% of a business's energy consumption. Lighting technologies developed in the last decade can help cut your lighting costs up to 60% while improving lighting and reducing environmental impacts.

The program offers cash incentives (from a limited program fund) to help cover the cost of a variety of energy-efficient upgrades. Here's how it works:

### **Get Started:**

- 1) Discuss project with your electric utility staff and pick up an application.
- 2) Obtain a contractor who will verify the project and complete the pre-authorization form.
- 3) Within 90 days of pre-authorization install qualifying energy-efficient lighting products listed above using the licensed contractor.
- 4) Complete the application form after installation.
- 5) Submit the signed application, along with proof of purchase (identified in the application's terms and conditions) to your local utility to receive the incentive within 4-6 weeks.
